Call to Order – Public Hearing: Meeting called to order at 4:00 p.m.

1. Public Hearing: Town Manager Hinton - The funds we get 2 years in a row, we get one at a time, \$100k. Ideas for that, Bore Project, anything extra could be used for pipes. SCADA system, although, may build a different grant for that. Road work possible, for example, East Ave. Spoke to an engineer and we figured what it might cost. We have 2,400 ft. by 30 ft. wide paving, base, curb, side walk and drain. That alone is over \$1M, without figuring in engineering costs.
Keith Dennis -SEAGO -Mr. Dennis takes a moment to introduce himself and briefly describe what CDBG does. -- In 2019 Duncan used CDBG to do a planning grant meeting they didn't actually do any work on the ground. It was to procure an engineer and do an environmental review clearance for the Hunter Estates area primarily, and it was for some work to be done on Chaparral Rd. and McGrath Ave. The area around the post office on Main Street would require less engineering and more of just repair. Colonias Grant: There is a possibility that next year we may be able to combine CDBG funds with a Colonias Grant.

The Colonias Grant can be used for:

- 1. Water
- 2. Wastewater
- 3. Flood Control
- 4. Housing Rehab. Owner occupied- low income.

**Sherriff Tim Sumner** - Housing: Older citizens, many houses that can be used for those whom cannot live in their own homes any longer.

Ideas for possible projects: Drainage at High Street, D Street, issues with drainage, high water flow, high washouts, water safety, water saving improvements, low flow shower heads, water systems. Senior Center that can also be used as a Youth Center - Community Center. Skate Park. Adding a park to Hunter Estates to keep kids from having to cross the highway.
